The Pledge of Allegiance was led by Lloyd Harper.

Others present –Dean Engelhart, Lloyd Harper, Jr., Greg Benner, Maude Bias, and Tim Perkins.

Frank R. made a motion to pay bills. Ron K. seconded the motion. The roll call was as follows: Frank Ruehr, Jr., and Ronald Kotkowski, Yes.

Dean Engelhart, Road Supervisor reported on the following:

1. Dean informed the BOT that the Forest Head that the road crew was renting from Leppo will be here Monday morning to clear and mulch the property south of the town hall.

Maude Bias; Secretary for Shalersville Township Zoning, Board of Zoning Appeals, and Assistant Fiscal Officer reported on the following:

1. The Shalersville Township Board of Zoning Appeals (BZA) will have a public meeting to hear a Conditional Use Permit presented by J. Allen on Thursday, June 22, 2023 at 6:30 p.m.

Greg Benner, Shalersville Zoning Inspector reported on the following:

1. Greg has issued 3 Zoning Permits for fences and an accessory building.
2. Greg has turned over two zoning non-compliant cases to the Portage County Prosecuting office. One was for the Shelly Co. and Geauga Paving Co. for the manufacturing and saleing asphalt products in a ARR District, and the second one was for Gary Brentlinger on St. Rt. 44 for a contractor yard.

Jill Corbett, Fiscal Officer reported on the following:

1. Jill received two Semi-Public Sewage Treatment Systems Inspection Reports from the Portage County Combined General Health District for the Shalersville Park and the Shalersville Town Hall. Both passed with a No Nuisance Observed reporting.
2. Jill informed the BOT the process to have Maude Bias, Assistant Fiscal Officer added our Middlefield Banking account, and the UAN Data Software program. The BOT agreed to move forward with this.

Ronald Kotkowski, Trustee reported on the following:

1. Ron reported that he has started the process of moving the old school house to the Shalersville Township Historical Society. The roof was moved there today.

Frank Ruehr, Jr., Trustee Chairman reported on the following:

1. Frank had the closed Bids for the construction of the new driveway and parking lot on the property south of the town hall. Frank opened the bids are as follows.
